2019 RACER REGISTRATION PACKET

Dear Parent or Guardian:

This packet provides information for the 2019 Greater Ohio Area SuperKids Classic Race being held on Saturday June 1, 2019. As our race is a qualifier for the National SuperKids Race, the top four winners of our race will be eligible to participate in the National SuperKids Race in July. Even if your child is not eligible to race this year, we hope you will share this information with friends and family that may have children who are eligible.

Racers eligible for 2019 Greater Ohio Area SuperKids Classic:

- must be between the ages of 7 and 18 on race day;
- must have a disability that would prevent them from participating in the All-American Soap Box Derby;
- must be cooperative when being loaded into the car and able to fit safely and comfortably with the co-pilot;
- and must not weigh more than 185lbs.

In order to ensure the safety of all racers, it is important that you read and understand what is expected of parents/guardians and your child on Practice and Race day. **Please read all this information carefully, complete all required forms and return no later than April 1, 2019.** What this packet includes:

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WHAT CAN PARENTS AND RACERS EXPECT?

Our race is a soap box derby style race (meaning cars are not motorized, relying completely on gravity and hand/manual breaks). Cars race downhill, reaching speeds up to 35 miles an hour. This sounds scary to adults, but kids love it, rarely do we have racers that are afraid to try. Once they experience the thrill of the hill, they will want to come back and race again and again!

CARS: Our cars are adapted especially for two passengers – our special Racer and an experienced co-pilot from the All-American Soap Box Derby. Cars do not have seatbelts, Racers and Co-Pilots sit closely and securely next to each other in the car. Racers must be able to sit inside the cars (keeping hands and arms inside the car). Co-Pilots are responsible for steering and pulling the handbrake. Experienced volunteers are onsite to help kids get in cars at the top of the hill, and out of cars at the bottom of the hill.

ENVIRONMENT: The Race environment can be very loud and busy (we use a PA system to make announcements; there is a loud bang at the starting line when the blocks holding cars in place are retracted to begin each race; and there is a busy crowd of parents and racers inside the Race Pavilion where kids wait for their turn to race). There are several parts of the day when your child may not be with you (but will be with authorized volunteers and board members who are easily identified by their shirts and/or nametags).

RACE: The race begins after the opening parade on race day (around 10:30 am) and continues until a first place winner is declared. Racers may go down the hill multiple times, and a minimum of two (if they keep winning, they will continue racing until the final heat that determines the top four racers). When racers reach the bottom of the hill, volunteers assist them in getting out of cars, and they are transported in a volunteer vehicle back to the top of the hill (where parents should be waiting to meet them when they are dropped off at the Race pavilion). Some Racers could be onsite/racing until mid to late afternoon. We also race rain or shine (except for severe rain or lightning conditions which we will determine onsite), so the day could be very hot or wet depending on the weather, dress accordingly.

INFORMATION YOU PROVIDE: The parent and physician forms required for this race are designed to help us understand how your child will interact with the race environment and cars, and how we can help them participate in this unforgettable experience. **We want your child to participate and have fun!** The information you give us helps us know what to expect (if needed and possible, helps us make special accommodations BEFORE race day). We also host a practice day at Derby Downs for new and returning racers who would like to participate in a ride down the hill before race day.

SUPPORT YOUR SUPERKID: TEAM T-SHIRTS

All racers are provided a free t-shirt with their name on it. There will be an opportunity for families to purchase additional shirts to show support for their racer: TEAM "YOUR CHILD'S NAME". Information for ordering TEAM shirts will be sent to those who register.

**PRACTICE DAY: Monday May 20th, 2019
5:30 - 8:00 pm**

A practice day for all Co-pilots, Racers and their parent/guardian will take place on May 20th at Derby Downs. Racers and parents should be in the pavilion by 5:30 pm for check-in. A parent meeting will take place at 6:00 pm. Light snacks and bottled water will be provided, if you are concerned about meals, snacks or food allergies you are welcome to bring your own. *Parents/Guardians are responsible for making sure their child/Racer is where he/she needs to be on Practice Day.*

LOCATION & PARKING: Derby Downs, 1000 George Washington Blvd, Akron, OH 44306. The bottom entrance (near Triplett Blvd) will be closed to cars/traffic on practice and race days. Access Derby Downs from the top of the hill, off of George Washington Blvd via Springfield Lake Boulevard. Drive down to the bleachers/bandstand area. Park in lower lot and walk up to Pavilion/Topside. If you need to drop off passengers requiring special assistance getting up the hill, PLEASE: drive slowly up to pavilion parking area, drop off passengers, and then return to park at the lower parking area. There is no parking at topside/pavilion area during Practice or Race Day.

PARTICIPANT RULES: Please see enclosed Participant Rules for additional information parents and guardians should know about Practice and Race Days.

**RACE DAY: Saturday June 1st, 2019
9:00 am - until winner declared**

Race day begins with Racer check in at 9:00 am in the Derby Downs pavilion. Lunch will be provided free to Racers, Volunteers, and one adult chaperone per Racer. Additional food and beverages will be available for purchase from vendors near Bandstand/bleachers. You are welcome to bring your own food, snacks and beverages. *Parents/Guardians are responsible for making sure their child/Racer is where he/she needs to be on Race Day.*

RACE PICNIC: Sunday June 2nd, 2019, 2:00 pm - 4:00 pm

A picnic for racers, families, volunteers and sponsors will take place June 2nd at the Greater Akron Motorcycle Club, 1540 Smith Road Akron Ohio 44313. Bring a Covered Dish to share, Fishing Poles, etc.

BANQUET: Wednesday, June 12th, 2019, 6:00 pm - 8:00 pm

Our 2019 racer and awards banquet will take place at Guy's Party Center, 500 East Waterloo Road Akron, OH 44319. All racers and one adult chaperone receive a complimentary ticket to the banquet. Additional tickets can be purchased for adults \$13, and kids age 12 and under \$8. Purchase additional tickets in advance or on Race Day (See Banquet Reservation form enclosed with Racer Registration Packet).

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Greater Ohio Area SuperKids Classic 2019 Practice & Race Day Rules

1. Safety is priority #1. while SuperKids exists so that your son/daughter/grandchild/client has a fun experience of the “Thrill of the Hill” at Derby Downs, safety comes first. Greater Ohio Area SuperKids Classic, Inc. has the right to refuse any child to race should there be any question that participation in this race may be unsafe for that child or may threaten the safety of others participating in the race. We also ask your assistance in following directions of the posted signs, including:
 - No smoking is permitted at Derby Downs
 - No alcoholic beverages allowed during the SuperKids racing events
 - Parking only in the parking lot near the bandstand/bleachers
2. Pavilion and Race Track Area - only the racers, one designated adult, our co-pilots and volunteers are permitted in these areas. Each designated person will have a wristband, name tag or sticker that identifies them. You are welcome to talk with family members and friends outside the restricted areas. Racers and designated adult chaperones will be identified by a wristband, nametag or sticker - please wear this item at all times in the restricted areas. This includes brothers or sisters unless they are the adult parental/guardian designee.
3. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR CHILD AT ALL TIMES. Racers must have a designated adult chaperone with them at all times except when he/she is racing in a SuperKids car or being transported back up to the pavilion. This person will remain outside the starting line area while the child is actually racing. Designated adult chaperones may be a parent, guardian, sibling over the age of 18, or another designee that is a responsible adult. If you are tag-teaming with another adult chaperone, make sure you trade off your wristband, nametag or sticker (or other identifier) when in restricted race and pavilion areas. We also ask that you:
 - Please watch and listen for your child’s name for the races. Volunteers will do their best to keep those in the pavilion informed of who will be racing next. We will then need YOU to bring your child to the line-up area.
 - Be careful of our vans, trucks and other vehicles driving between the pavilion and port-a-potties.
 - Between races, feel free to take advantage of the activity table areas.
4. Pictures - You are welcome to take pictures of your child on practice and race day. Please know that we also have photographers snapping shots throughout the day.
 - Before you take photos of someone else’s child, be sure to have permission from their adult.
 - IF YOU DO NOT WANT YOUR CHILD PHOTOGRAPHED, notify a Board member in advance of Practice or Race day and your child will receive a special wristband so that we know your wishes. We will do our best to inform any news agents, but you will also want to keep an eye out for cameras.
5. Racer & Family Comfort
 - On Practice Day, light snacks and bottled water will be available for everyone. On Race Day, bottled water (while supplies last) and a light lunch will be provided free to racers, co-pilots and one designated adult per racer. Lunch will be donated by one of our generous sponsors. You are welcome to bring your own food for additional family members joining you. Additional food will be available for sale on Race Day near the bleachers. On both days, if you are concerned about meal times or food allergies, you are welcome to bring your own food/snacks and beverages (no alcohol permitted).
 - The pavilion offers limited tables/seating areas. We encourage you to bring lawn/camp chairs for additional seating in/near the pavilion, and blankets for the grassy areas alongside the hill.
6. Help us to keep Derby Downs clean - trash bins are provided for our use around the facilities. Thank you for helping us to keep the area clean!
